Pray: Simply Begin and Begin Simply

[Jesus said,] "Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. Is there anyone among you who, if your child asked for bread, would give a stone? Or if the child asked for a fish, would give a snake? If you, then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

Encouragement for the Lenten Journey:

Have you ever wondered if your prayers are being heard? In all fairness there probably isn't a one of us who hasn't struggled with our prayer life at some point in time. Some of us have gotten so discouraged that we no longer have a disciplined prayer life. We have convinced ourselves that our prayers are inadequate; that they aren't getting through; and that God is not listening.

A vital, meaningful prayer life doesn't just happen. Prayer is something that you learn and that you grow into. To our knowledge, the disciples never asked how to walk on water, or how to heal, or how to preach. The only written record of them asking how to do something was this, "Lord, teach us how to pray."

Jesus prayed often. It was His praying that prompted the request from the disciples to be taught. They realized that prayer was a vital and influential part of Jesus's everyday life and His ministry. They were witnesses to the amazing spiritual power that was released in Jesus through the practice of prayer.

Some of us are frustrated and discouraged in our prayer life because we're not certain where to begin. Let me suggest that you simply begin and begin simply. God is not interested in the elaborate nature of your prayers; He just wants to hear from you; anytime, anywhere you want to have a conversation with God. Continue to knock at the door of God's heart. It is our persistence that reveals our hearts greatest desires and needs.

How can we know that God still answers prayer? It is in our belief that God will not fail us where His persistence in reaching out to us, and our persistence in asking, meet in the common desire for His Kingdom to come on earth even as it is in heaven.

In this season of penitence and self-examination, what do you need to grow in your relationship with Christ? What are you searching for in your faith journey? Pray. God is listening. "For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened."
